APPLICATION & ELIGIBILITY

All students who wish to change their college affiliation must complete an application for intercollege transfer. Only those students admitted to a degree-seeking college may utilize the intercollege transfer process. If you are currently withdrawn from the University you must complete the Readmission Application and submit that form and a \$25 non-refundable application fee with this application. Former and current non-degree students cannot use this application. They must apply through the Admissions Office using the formal admissions process.

Please: 1) Complete this form. 2) Request an advising transcript (no charge). 3) Submit both this completed application and transcript to the appropriate office in the college to which you are applying:

College of Liberal Arts / College of Science and Mathematics: Assistant Director of Undergraduate Education, Office of Undergraduate Education, Campus Center 2-2100. Deadline for submission of this form is the end of the add-drop period each semester.

College of Management: CM Welcome Center, McCormack Hall, 5th floor, room 603. CM has a rolling admissions policy. Intercollege transfer applications are evaluated between January 1 and April 1 for the fall semester, and between June 1 and October 1 for the spring semester.

College of Nursing and Health Sciences:

Dept. of Nursing: Student Affairs Specialist, CNHS, Science Building, 2nd floor, room 02-15G. The nursing program only accepts intercollege transfer applications for the fall semester; the deadline is March 1st. Please include transcripts from all colleges and universities attended.

Dept. of Exercise and Health Sciences: EHS Program Coordinator, CNHS, Science Building, 3rd floor, room 301-10. The exercise and health sciences program accepts applications for both the fall and spring semesters.

College of Public and Community Service: CPCS Student Services, Wheatley Building, 4th floor, room 151. The College of Public and Community Service has a rolling admissions policy.

It is the student's responsibility to fulfill all conditions set by the college of application. You will be notified by mail by the college of application when a decision has been made.

ADMISSION

Transfer is not guaranteed. Each student will be evaluated individually to determine acceptability into the college of application. Admission into all colleges is based upon both the availability of space and the student's demonstrated ability to succeed.

TRANSFER CREDIT

Upon acceptance to a new college, all prior earned credits (UMass Boston as well as other institutions) will be reevaluated for applicability to the new college. Be advised that a change in college can result in the loss of earned credit towards graduation.

PLEASE NOTE: STUDENTS WHO ARE APPLYING FOR AN INTERCOLLEGE TRANSFER AND WHO ARE CURRENTLY WITHDRAWN FROM THE UNIVERSITY MUST SUBMIT A \$25 NON-REFUNDABLE APPLICATION FEE AND AN APPLICATION FOR READMISSION WITH THIS APPLICATION.
