



Online RN-to-BS: Bachelor of Science in Nursing

The Program

The College of Nursing and Health Sciences, in conjunction with the Division of Corporate, Continuing and Distance Education, offer an online Bachelor of Science degree program in nursing for Registered Nurses. The online format maximizes accessibility and convenience for highly motivated, independent professionals.

Once students begin the nursing courses, they proceed through the program in a cohort for five semesters. Nursing courses are taught online in the summer, fall and spring sessions.

Accreditation

The Online RN-BS Program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education.

On Campus Requirement?

Although most course activity is completed online, students will have 3 opportunities to come to campus. The first is to attend an on-campus orientation prior to beginning the online nursing courses. In addition there is an opportunity to come to campus during the Health Assessment and Promotion course. Students from out of state may contact the program office to discuss arrangements for completing these requirements.

Degree Requirements

- Successful completion of all online nursing courses
- 120 overall credits
- Successful completion of the Writing Proficiency Requirement
- Successful completion of the required elective courses.

Credit for Previous Nursing Education

A total of 41 credits will be awarded to students in the Online RN-BS Program upon successful completion of the first online nursing course, NU 360, Professional Issues in Nursing. These credits are awarded as transfer credits and are considered equal to your previous nursing education.

Tuition and Fees

As of the fall 2009 semester, the cost for an online course is \$320.00 per credit. *Please note that this is subject to change.*

Additional Requirements

The non-nursing general education and elective requirements may be completed at any time prior to graduation and may be satisfied by courses offered through the Division of Corporate, Continuing, and Distance Education, if available, or (with prior approval) through another accredited college or university.
