## SECTION VII: Residency Information

For the purpose of assessing tuition and fees, each student shall be classified as a "Massachusetts resident" or a "Non-Massachusetts resident." A person shall be classified as a Massachusetts resident if he/she (or the parent of a non-emancipated student) shall have resided in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts for purposes other than attending an educational institution for twelve months immediately preceding entry or re-entry as a student. Physical presence for the entire twelve-month period need not be required as long as the conduct of the individual, taken in total, manifests an intention.
