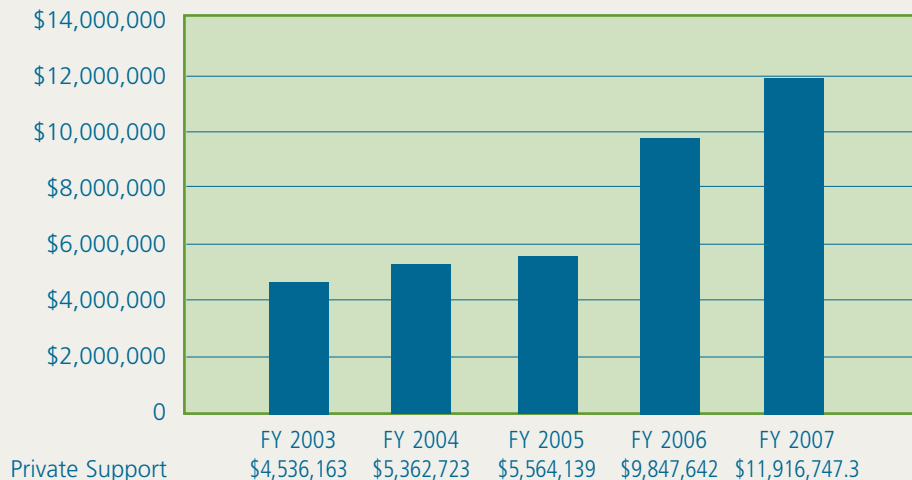

## The Chancellor's Council—United in Support



When Ben Garcia read about the new Chancellor's Council last fall, it felt like a personal invitation. The council, which brings together alumni, friends, and corporations and foundations united in their annual support of the university, provided the perfect chance for Garcia "to give back." As an educator at the J. Paul Getty Museum in Los Angeles, he knew his alma mater had much to do with his success. After a false start at a traditional age, Garcia flourished at UMass Boston in his late 20s, by then determined to pursue his professional aspirations in the arts.

Small classes with faculty mentors such as Paul Tucker, Nancy Stieber, and Pamela Jones made all the difference to Garcia. "Their love for teaching and commitment to students established a model for me," says Garcia, now associate director of education at the Skirball Cultural Center in Los Angeles. "I used to give annual gifts to the Art Department, but the Chancellor's Council enables me to formalize my commitment and gives the university the flexibility to respond to changing needs," says Garcia, whose \$500 gift was matched by the J. Paul Getty Trust.

an outstanding senior graduating from the Honors Program. “The fellowship is designed to enlarge their perspective about the world and what it means to be a global citizen,” says Rajini Srikanth, honors program director and associate professor of English.

The donors have also made provisions in their estates to establish an endowed directorship for the head of the Honors Program and to provide grants to humanities students wishing to study abroad. The endowed directorship will help attract persons of stature and commitment to that position and will allow money currently designated for salary to be used for undergraduate research and other initiatives.

Blair, one of the early directors of the program, notes: “Professor Monica McAlpine significantly expanded the academic scope of the Honors Program, and it is now ably headed by Professor Srikanth. It is a pleasure to be able to support outstanding students and to help shape the future of the Honors Program.”

# A Fruitful Partnership for Urban Schooling



As a student-teacher at Dorchester High School, Pamela Trefler learned first hand about the complex issues that influence success for urban kids. As a philanthropist, she transformed her insight into concrete action by investing in Dorchester High School at a critical moment. Trefler's philanthropy provided major momentum for the school to restructure into smaller learning communities and forged a three-way partnership between UMass Boston's Graduate College of Education, the university's successful pre-collegiate programs, and Dorchester High, now the Dorchester Education Complex (DEC).

Teach Next Year, the program that emerged, simultaneously improves teaching and learning at DEC and gives teacher-preparation at UMass Boston a stronger urban focus. The year-long program features UMass Boston summer courses followed by integrated graduate study and teaching at DEC. Trefler gifts have leveraged resources for Teach Next Year from the Nellie Mae Education and Noyce Foundations, although additional funding is still needed for the program to achieve its full promise.

"I am so pleased by the continuing partnership between UMass Boston and DEC," says Trefler. "Teach Next Year, which has been a cornerstone of that partnership, has created a powerful track record in preparing teacher-leaders for urban schools. It is a legacy in which the Trefler Foundation takes great pride."

## Fit2Lead—Inspiring Healthy Living



When Professor Kyle McInnis (back row, far right) first met the cluster of Dorchester high schoolers on a hot July morning for a pilot program at GoKids Boston, the university's new interdisciplinary youth fitness center, they were eating "breakfast"—Doritos and soda. The research director of the center knew he had a long way to go. But by the end of the summer, the eight junior fitness leaders engaged in the Fit2Lead initiative had altered their eating habits and found inspiration to consider the field of exercise science as a profession.

Offered with the support of the Boston Public Schools, Fit2Lead is one of several innovative health and fitness programs for at-risk, inner-city teens that GoKids Boston has created in partnership with hospitals, schools, and community groups. The center offers clinical investigators across multiple institutions and disciplines the chance to collaborate on developing, testing, and disseminating evidenced-based strategies to get kids more physically active. "Fit2Lead has demonstrated the tremendous potential of our center to create new protocols that promote fitness with community organizations and schools," says McInnis.

## Helping Parents Intervene Against Autism



Today, one child in every 150 is diagnosed with autism, making it more common than pediatric cancer, diabetes, and AIDS combined. While there are no specific medical treatments or cures, psychology professor Alice Carter, with the generous assistance of the Autism Speaks Foundation, is conducting significant research on early intervention for those who have been diagnosed or are at high risk of being diagnosed. Her \$1.2 million grant project studies how family factors, including parenting practices that enhance a child's linguistic competence, may be important predictors of long-term



outcomes for children with a variety of disabilities.

"We believe that this research will ensure that families have access to the most effective early-intervention treatments," says Carter. "The families in our pilot group were uniformly enthusiastic about the approaches introduced," she adds. "The work of Alice Carter and her colleagues represents a very important contribution, and we are grateful for her dedication to the field and to finding the answers," says Andy Shih, vice president for scientific affairs at Autism Speaks.

## Advancing Peace Through the John Joseph Moakley Chair



In a fractured world there are few places in more urgent need of understanding than Iraq, with its devastating conflicts between Sunnis and Shiites. Donors to the John Joseph Moakley Chair of Peace and Reconciliation, established in 2006 through its holder, Padraig O'Malley (left in photo), and housed in the McCormack Graduate School of Policy Studies, are helping to bring about such understanding, creating the foundation for reconciliation in that war-torn society.

In early September 2007, secret talks were organized by the McCormack School and a Helsinki-based organization among leaders from Iraq, Northern Ireland, and South Africa. The Moakley Chair positioned Padraig O'Malley to engage these leaders in conversations about peace initiatives in the latter two societies and their possible applications in Iraq, thus advancing negotiations about non-violence, independent and effective courts, and the protection of human rights. "The university believes that a public policy school should be deeply involved in public policy issues," says McCormack School Dean Steve Crosby (right in photo). "Clearly, the Moakley Chair is making a huge difference."

When Professor Peter Kiang received the 2007 Chancellor's Distinguished Teaching Award at last June's commencement, he recognized that his development during the past two decades of the strongest Asian American studies program in the region would not have been possible without the steady financial support of individual donors.

He recalls that in 1992, for example, ten percent of all donors to the university contributed to support the expansion of the program. One alumna at the time was so grateful for having learned about Asian American history and her own Cambodian refugee roots that she began saving small amounts of cash each week and eventually handed Kiang a paper bag filled with bills totaling \$1,000.

Today, this alumna is a successful entrepreneur in Lowell and continues to support the Asian American Studies Program. She is joined by many others,

including one generous donor this past year who enabled an entire class of Asian American studies students to spend spring break on the Gulf Coast working on post-Katrina Vietnamese-community rebuilding projects. According to Kiang, "such philanthropic reciprocity is powerful. The community invests in our program while our teaching is an investment in the future of the community."

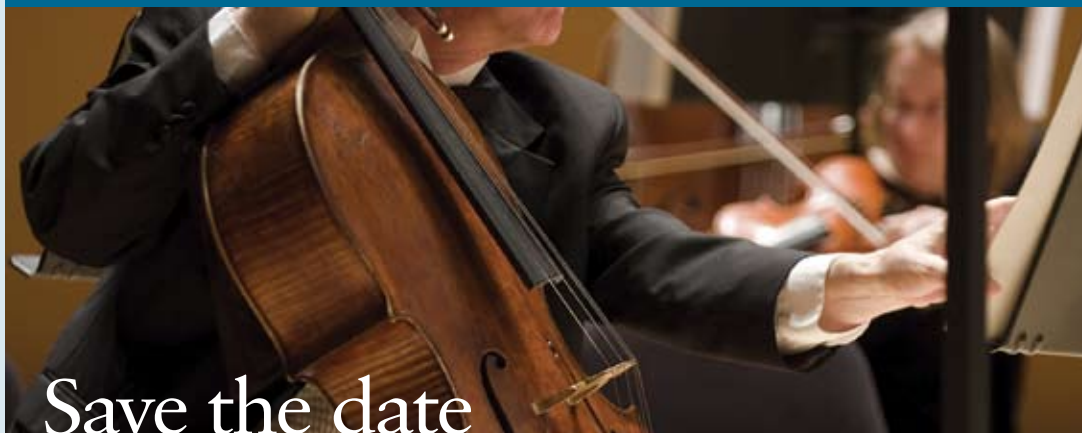
