Targeted and locally administered oversamples (i.e., non-randomly selected students) are not included in this report.
${ }^{\text {c }}$ Sampling error is an estimate of the margin by which the true score for your institution on a given item could differ from the reported score.
To interpret the sampling error, assume that $60 \%$ of your students reply "very often" to a particular item. If the sampling error is $+/-5 \%$, then the true population value is most likely between $55 \%$ and $65 \%$.
