Porch and Deck Safety

During the month of May every year, people are encouraged to check their decks with a critical eye to safety.



To help minimize porch and deck collapse at you residence, please inspect your exterior for the following:

- ✓ Loose and corroded fasteners: All hardware should be tight throughout the deck and especially the ledger area
- ✓ <u>Split or decaying wood:</u> All would should be in good condition and should not show any signs of wood rot
- ✓ <u>Ledger board</u>: This is the main board on the deck that connects a deck to a house. This should be in good condition and provide a secure foundation for attaching a deck to a house. Problems with ledger boards are most common cause of deck collapses
- ✓ Sagging floors or roofs.
