The Departmental Model, per Article 35.6.A of the faculty collective bargaining agreement, with the Department retaining intellectual property rights and the Course Developer receiving a negotiated stipend of \$ This is a negotiated agreement that locates the intellectual property rights to the online course content and materials within the sponsoring Department. The course may be taught by multiple and varied instructors, as assigned by the Department Chair. The negotiated stipend has been agreed upon by the Course Developer, the University, and the Faculty Staff Union.		
	B. The Non-Departmental ("Individual") Model, per Article 35.6.B of the faculty collective bargaining agreement, with the Course Developer retaining intellectual property rights and receiving a \$3000 stipend. The payment of the stipend shall entitle the Department or College to the continued use of the course content and materials as developed/adapted provided such use is consistent with the terms and conditions specified in the Agreement. The Course Developer shall have the right of first refusal should this course be offered in subsequent semesters. If the Course Developer elects not to teach this course, and another faculty member teaches this course without substantial adjustments in course materials, the College will pay the Course Developer a stipend of \$500 per course offering.
