Special Topics Course: Intent to Schedule

A special topics course may be offered in two <u>consecutive</u> semesters (Fall/Spring of one academic year, or Spring/Fall of consecutive academic years), as long as it is submitted for governance approval before the start of the second semester.

Special topics courses at the graduate level must be approved by the Dean of Graduate Studies before they will be issued a schedule number. Please submit this form, along with a syllabus, *two weeks before the schedule for the relevant semester is due to the collegiate dean's office*.
