There are two types of undergraduate memberships

Regular Member (one-time fee of \$55)

Requirements:

- Is an undergraduate Biology Major – *2nd semester sophomore or higher*
- Completed at least *three biology classes* (Bio 111 & 112 + one 200-level course or higher), with minimum of *two* Biology courses completed at UMB
- Has a *3.0 average* (or higher) - calculated for *all Biology courses completed*
- Is in good academic standing
- This is a lifetime membership; it comes with an honor cord

Associate Member (one-time fee of \$45)

- *Anyone* that interested in biology *but ineligible to join as a Regular Member*
- This membership ends upon graduation or departure from UMB
- Once an Associate Member meets the criteria to become a Regular Member, they can change their status to become a Regular Member for an additional fee of \$10 -> "Promoted Member".
