CONRES 603: Advanced Negotiation/Mediation-Gender and Conflict

The course focuses on examining the relationship between gender, violet conflict, security and peacebuilding. In this class, we will consider: how do gender stereotypes influence the ways that we think about conflict and peacebuilding? How can gender as a relational category, among race, class nationality and others be used for the analysis of inequalities? The overall goal will be to gain an understanding of the gendered dimensions of conflict and peacebuilding and explore programmic approaches by working on case studies that elucidate these complexities.

CONRES 690: Court Mediation Internship

This is a 6-credit course which involves both a regular class meeting and spending a half-day per week in court for four months. In court, students mediate actual cases under the direction of a supervisor/coach. Students are paced in courts in Quincy or Dorchester that are accessible by public transportation. There is also a required two-day pre-court training workshop in January. Completion of the course fulfils requirements of the Guidelines for Implementation of Qualification Standards for Neutrals in Massachusetts. ConRES 636 Conflict in Workgroups

This course provides the participant with an opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of the dynamics of work groups, with an emphasis on processes of conflict within them, and to develop skills to deal constructively with intra- and inter- group conflict. Class sessions will deal with conceptual issues in a combination of lecture and seminar-discussion format, drawing from various literatures on groups. Students will also participate in weekly meetings with a small workgroup, consisting of a sub-set of the class, which will offer an opportunity to study group processes in vivo with the aid of a facilitator.
