SECTION I: TO BE COMPLETED BY EXCHANGE STUDENT

- 1. Search the class catalog under the Semester and Year you would like to study at UMass Boston. Fall courses are typically available to view online in mid-March, and Spring courses are typically available to view online in mid-October. https://courses.umb.edu/course catalog/search
- 2. Undergraduate Students: Please select the top 4 courses you would like to take during your exchange to UMass Boston, with 4 alternative courses on the chart below. Graduate Students, select the top 3 courses you would like to take during your exchange, with 3 alternative courses in the chart below. Notes on restricted courses:
 - Courses not open to exchange students: Exchange Students are not able to take Nursing courses, courses that are designated first or second-year seminars (any course with a "G" such as AMST 100G), ESL courses, Capstone courses (senior seminar), Clinical Psychology graduate courses, or more than 1 (maximum) online or remote course.
 - **Pre-requisite requirements**: Check under the course description if the course you are selecting has pre-requisite course requirements. These are courses that must have been taken in order to enroll in the course. You will designate in the table below which courses on your home university transcript you have taken that show this pre-requisite course(s) have been met for enrollment.
 - Math pre-requisites: If you are taking a course with a Math pre-requisite and have not taken the course at your home university, you will need to take the Math placement exam: https://www.umb.edu/academics/seas/aces/testing-services/math/
- 3. Seek approval from your home university to take these courses. All courses submitted on this form must be pre-approved by your university to ensure you receive permission before enrollment starts.
- 4. It may be difficult to change your course selections after submission of this form, as courses at UMass Boston fill quickly, and may not be available. If you need a course syllabus, check the faculty teaching your course and email them to ask for the syllabus. To find their email address, search their name here: https://www.umb.edu/directory/
